




There are 3 prime areas of learning and development and 4 specific areas of learning and development.

There are 3 prime areas:

Personal, Social and Emotional development	Communication and language	Physical development
Developing confidence and managing feelings and behaviours 	Listening and attention, understanding and speaking 	Improving control and co-ordination of the body and other objects and basic hygiene and understanding of healthy and safe choices. 

There are 4 specific areas:

Literacy	Mathematical development	Understanding the World	Expressive arts and design
Learning phonics and using sounds to support reading and writing development 	Understanding of numbers and shapes and introducing position and measurement 	People and communities, the world and uses of technology 	Exploring uses of colour, shape, sound, movement and stories
