MSA Required

School requires a Midday Supervisor for 7.5hrs per week for 1.5 hours per day (11.45am to 1.15pm).

The successful candidate must be willing to help within the hall for lunches, including setting up the hall with tables and chairs, cleaning equipment, managing waste collection and supervising the children. The role at times will also include outside play duties involving supervising the children, structuring and arranging games and play activities for the children across the school.

Patience and good behaviour management skills are essential, along with a good sense of humour. You will be supported by colleagues who are enthusiastic about their contribution to pupil development and table manners.

Assessment Time

SATs week for Key Stage 2 is nationally arranged for the week beginning 9th May 2016. All Year 6 children will be participating in the tests. Optional SATs will be the following week.

Year Two SATs testing will take place throughout May, and therefore children need to be in school during this time.

Year One Phonics Screening will be taking place during the week commencing 13th June 2016 and is a Government requirement.

Therefore, please ensure your child is in school during this period. Absences during this time may be classified as unauthorised.
