On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June a team of four of Cranwell's finest mathematicians, Cerys Batt, Scarlett Enright, Ryan McAndrew and Angus Taylor, attended the annual Inter-Primary School Mathematics Competition at St George's Academy, Sleaford. It was a fiercely contended match, with fifteen schools pitching their wits in a series of very challenging rounds. The children had to work together and apply their knowledge and understanding to questions such as:
