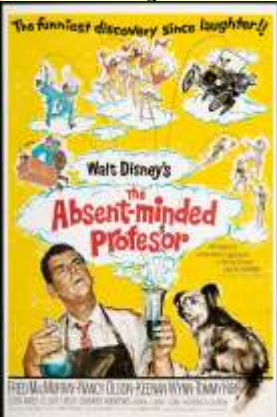
Film Club
