If School has to Close

If you are unsure whether the school will be open on a day when it snows, please listen to Lincs FM, their respective websites and Parentmail which will all provide relevant information as to whether we are open or not. A decision will be made at the earliest opportunity, but sometimes is not able to be made until 8am, therefore remain at home until the latest time possible to safely travel to school. Please note, even when these establishments are contacted by school, it can often take a considerable time for the information to be available for broadcasting or uploading.

The decision to close is not taken lightly, and there are a number of factors taken into account including: the safety of the school site, the ability for children to get to school and home safely, and are there sufficient members of staff to supervise the children on the premises.

If School closes, the Before and After School Club (BASC) will also be closed. If your children have already been dropped off at school, the BASC staff will notify parents for immediate collection. Thank you for your support in this matter.
