To help celebrate the day, we welcome children, if they wish, to come to school dressed in their favourite Roald Dahl book character.

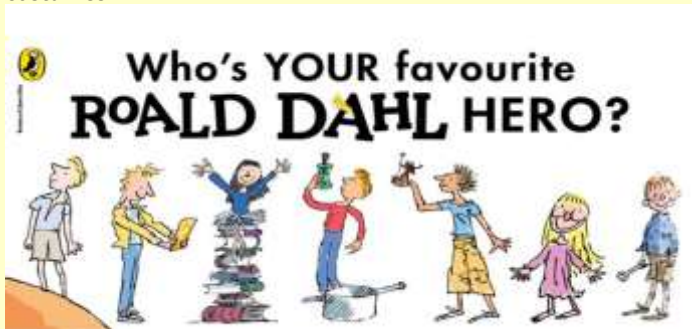
Some classes have chosen a certain book to focus on during the school day on the 1st March.
