- Very happy! Thank you.
- Would love more opportunities for Foundation Stage and KS1 extra-curricular clubs.
- The issue of all homework in one go can be a little overwhelming but it is good to avoid forgetting an item if it is spaced out through the week.
- Comms can be improved by better use of the school website to pass messages or use of Facebook and twitter to post urgent information.
- Love the communication book and Tapestry as a parent who doesn't often collect / drop at school times I feel completely in the loop with the communication book.
- I don't think I can confidently say either way the impact of Athletics. The kids enjoy doing it though.
- Question 10 - Neither agree nor disagree - I prefer the written maths. My child enjoys Athletics however, we use screen time as a privilege and it does use up screen time.
- A great school and great teachers all my children have enjoyed coming to this school and would definitely recommend it and previously have.
- Gates open late in the morning. 'Bump notes' not always given appropriately (got one for grazed knee but not lump on head - same incident)
- Only does Athletics when it is set as homework.
- Very pleased with daughter's progress. She loves school and is very much enjoying her time in class.
- Very happy with the school, communication and activities offered. Particularly pleased with before and after school club care.
- Child is new to this school and we are all delighted! He is receiving fantastic support and help catching up and adapting to a new school system.
- Daughter really enjoys school, great comms and feels happy and safe. Before and after school club is fantastic, she loves going, the teachers are brill and definitely deserve recognition for their hard work. Many thanks.

- Too much homework / reading / letters and sounds from Foundation! Like the Tapestry tasks though. We don't use Mathletics, my daughter makes good progress despite this.
- Mathletics is for visual learners.

- The boys like this school and enjoy coming here.
- My children prefer pen and paper.
- Ref Question 9 - while homework is age appropriate the volume of homework set may not be.
- Ref 2/13 - my child switches from being happy to not happy at the school and this is down to social situations on playground and one particular pupil but the class teacher is aware and being helpful.
- Too much homework, making learning too stressful for such young children.
- Fantastic school - couldn't be happier.

- I like the support you give to the children when a parent is away, like the Bluey Club.
- Sometimes child complains that she gets disrupted by kids in class.
- Very happy children - very happy parents! Thank you.
- Disappointed about lack of communication at the start of year, regarding what class / teacher child would be having.
- Very pleased with Cranwell Primary School. Child seems to be progressing well. Seems very friendly.
- We have heard CPS praised for their exceptional school from people as far away as Grantham, even recommendation.
- I feel that my child is given too much homework.
- Too many emails from ParentMail each day.
- We are extremely happy with all aspects of the school. Thank you.
- Q8 - I think child preferred getting homework daily that had to be in the next day.
- Q12 - I think there is a child in class that has additional needs and sometimes my child finds that disruptive.
- Excellent School.
- My negative comment is some of the homework is too difficult i.e. designing leaflets etc. and requires significant parent involvement.
- Although we feel the homework is a lot for 4 year olds to deal with, it is producing positive results.
- Sometimes child gets overlooked when he is struggling - he is quite quiet and doesn't speak up when he needs to. Also, gets distracted easily and I worry about him falling behind.
- The new Parentmail system is a welcome addition to the information network for school. A year planner would be good.
- This school has really helped my daughter. She has had lots of support. The opportunities have been excellent.
- Sometimes more individual homework would be great to reflect their academic level.
- Excellent school, with fantastic teachers. We couldn't ask for anything more.
- Foundation Staff (and all the team) are amazing and support my child so much. Thank you for all you do.
- Excellent school. Happy that my children attend. Superb standard of teaching. My only point would be that the breakfast/after school club is expensive.
- Can't comment on bullying as I have no experience.
- There are often issues with Mathletics so child doesn't go onto it regularly as she would like.
