THE WEATHER & TEMPERATURE

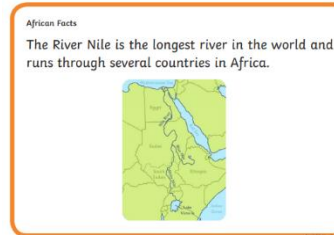
Track the weather in Kenya over the next two weeks. Use the internet to do this. Keep a note of the temperatures recorded and write a summary of the weather each day.

AFRICAN FACTS

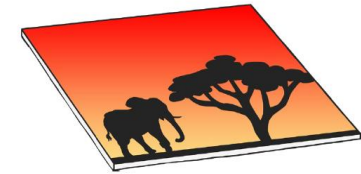
Create your own fact file all about Africa. You can present these facts in any way you please, you might like to produce your very own fact cards.

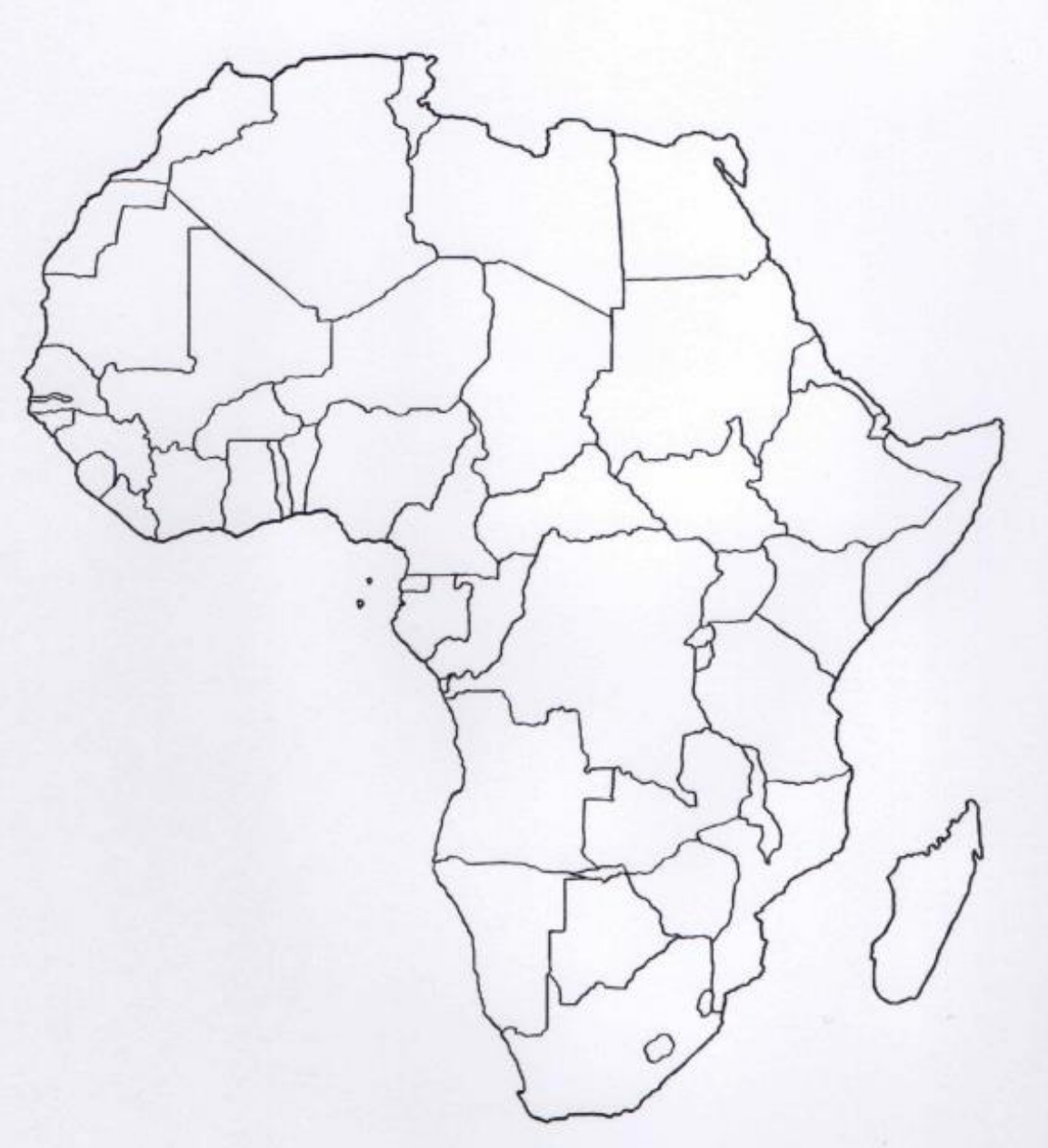
Read a few folk tales from Africa.
